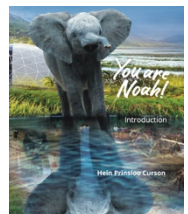

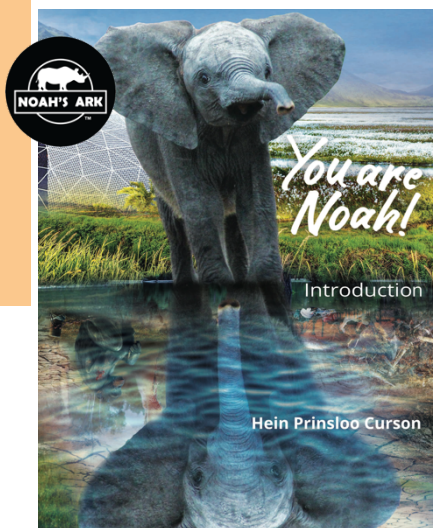

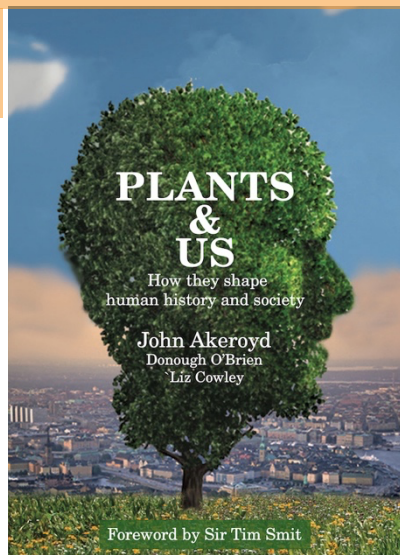

Autobiology of a Vet

John Sauvage

The life story of a practising veterinary surgeon – from the suburbs of South London to rural Kent via Africa

Opening with his Membership of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons, the book relates John's personal history and that of his English and Belgian family in 2 World Wars.

Recounted are tales from his studies and career, including vaccinations and the anti-vaccine lobby, also badgers and TB. Meeting children with thalidomide-induced injury is both life-affirming and tear-jerking.

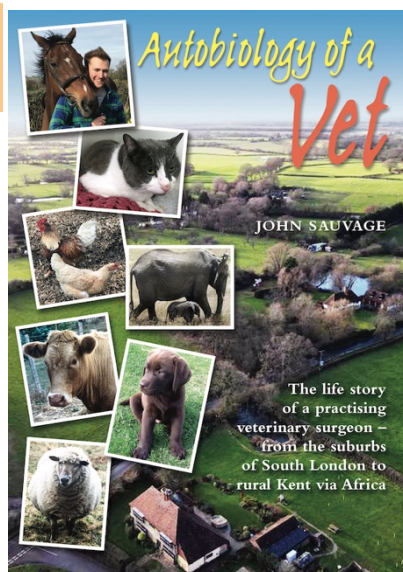
His time in East Africa, including his experiences in Uganda under Idi Amin's dictatorship, is chilling but still funny and up-lifting. The tales of his experiences in general and specialist veterinary practice, with memorable farm, horse, dog and cat cases are enlightening, educational and sometimes sad but often very hilarious. The horrific experiences with foot-and-mouth disease will get any animal lover in tears and questioning what happened and why? But the option of a Vegan Utopia in a world without farm animals is dismissed as a sad alternative as demonstrated when large swathes of the United Kingdom were left without stock after the outbreak.

Nature has checks and balances to deal with changes in conditions, such as female kangaroos becoming infertile in droughts, now humans must yet again evolve, in space.

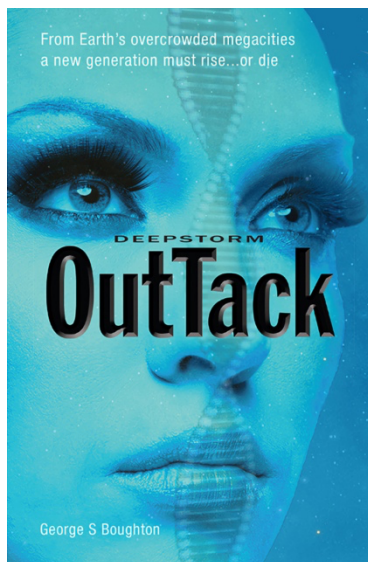
Meanwhile mounting natural disasters have escalated migrations to impossible levels, and wars, disrupting relief operations, now extend to the Territories.

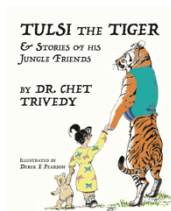

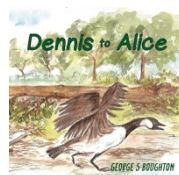

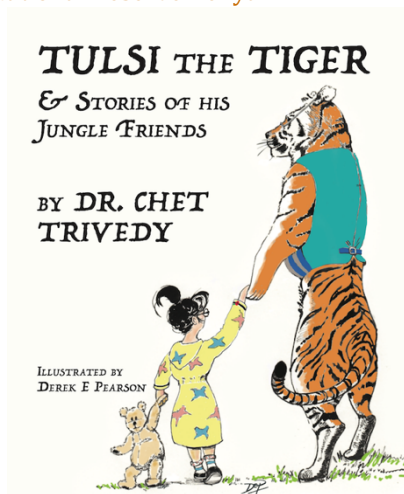
Poppy herself makes the journey of growing up into a conservationist. In the end, it is Poppy's children who learn the secret of the first story.

Hoping to raise awareness Trivedy dedicates his book profits to the Tulsi Foundation that, with the support of an Indian wildlife charity, has trained over 1,100 rangers in 14 tiger reserves across three states in Central India. Supporting staff is key to saving habitats and safeguarding species for future generations.

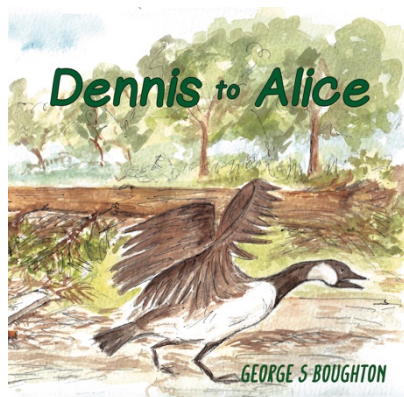

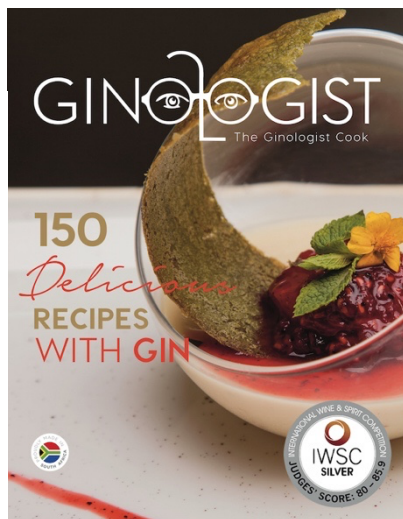

Boughton was a young oil engineer, newly married with their daughter on the way, when the Biafran War broke out. While expats were all ordered to evacuate that region of Nigeria, arrangements for Pamela Boughton involved her climbing a rope ladder, 3 months pregnant, to board an oil tanker. A small group of just 60 staff members, George Boughton among them, had to remain at the start of a war destined to be one of the worst episodes in African history and to which the international media only began to gain access over a year later.

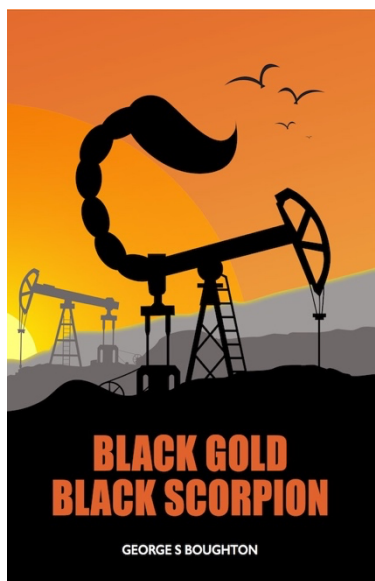

Starting with a review of the 2016 referendum and its aftermath, the author moves on to consider the wider problems we are facing. This includes a close look at: the work of our regulatory bodies, who have become a billion pound industry covering everything from regulation of the press to the funding of political parties, and communications to the supply of gas and electricity; also the criminal justice system, broadcasting and overseas aid.

Author Biography

The author drifted into journalism editing the student newspaper at the University of Canterbury in New Zealand. Subsequently, while turning his attention to economics and accounting, he worked on agricultural publications. Then, living in the UK, he edited an assortment of trade and professional publications until his retirement in 2016, since when, as an ageing and slightly cynical writer, he has turned his attention to investigating political machinations and the structure of governmental and regulatory bodies in the UK and elsewhere, along with various other aspects of life in general.

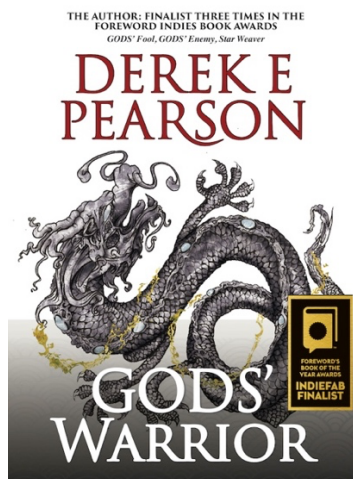
The enigmatic Preacher Spindrift's GODS having deserted him, he is now the last of his kind remaining on Earth.
